

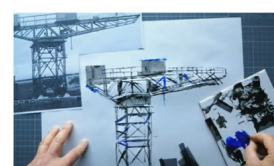
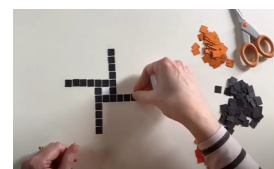
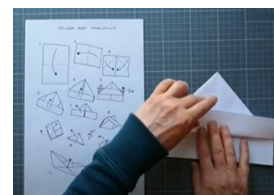
Free Activities & Resources Now Available Online
